

**Notes of a Committee Meeting of the 103rd Entry Association held at Berinsfield at
11.00 hrs on 11th June 2016**

1. Minutes of last meeting were accepted.

2. **Matters Arising:**

- BRN had written to Chris Jordan about John Jordan's subscription, but had not received a reply.
- Ten Tors article - MFHW had provided an article for the Haltonian magazine.
- MW & BRN had advertised the increased subscription rate, and amended the bank SO mandate.
- Triennial - LS reported that the take-up by our members is poor.
- A member's health status was clarified.

3. **Treasurers Report**

- Following the introduction of the increased subs some 25 members had not changed their SO mandate. Another 4 have not paid (**MW to contact**). One deceased member's subscription is still active (**BGL to talk to Dianne Hope**) and our honorary Boy Entrant has also paid (**BRN to write to Karen Hale**). The SO mandate to be reviewed to ensure that it is current; **MW/BRN to resolve**.
- There is £1213.77 in the account, which will increase by approx £145 once all outstanding SOs are updated. Recent expenses had been £30 for Help for Heroes, and £39 for Newsletter costs.

4. **Reunion 2018:** there had been very little input from our members. Options for the Sunday are the Vulcan Aviation Academy & Heritage Centre at Robin Hood Airport, the Scampton Heritage Centre, or Lincoln Castle/Cathedral/Shopping. **BRN to contact the Vulcan Academy to see what they can offer; KB to check out Scampton and Lincoln.** The Sunday venue will dictate where we stay on the Saturday night. Arrangements to be finalized at the December committee meeting.

5. **Newsletter:** BGL has had little input from the membership! It was agreed to publish a newsletter regularly twice a year - January and July. LG to write a piece on the Trenchard Museum; BRN to produce a summary of the committee meeting; BGL to include the Triennial notice from the previous newsletter.

6. **AOB.** MFHW had toured the North of Scotland and had visited Jim Dartnall.
